## 2016 capital increase fully subscribed

Lausanne, 29 September 2016

We are pleased to announce that the subscription period for new units in the Realstone Swiss Property fund came to a successful close on 23 September 2016. The fund manager's objective was fully met, as the entire issue of **918,931** units was subscribed, for a total of **CHF 112.3 million**. The issue date for the new units will be **30 September 2016**.

As previously announced, the proceeds from the issue will be used primarily for major investments aimed at renovating and increasing the density of existing buildings and to complete current construction projects. They will also be used to reduce the fund's debt ratio. These investments are fully in line with the fund's management strategy.
